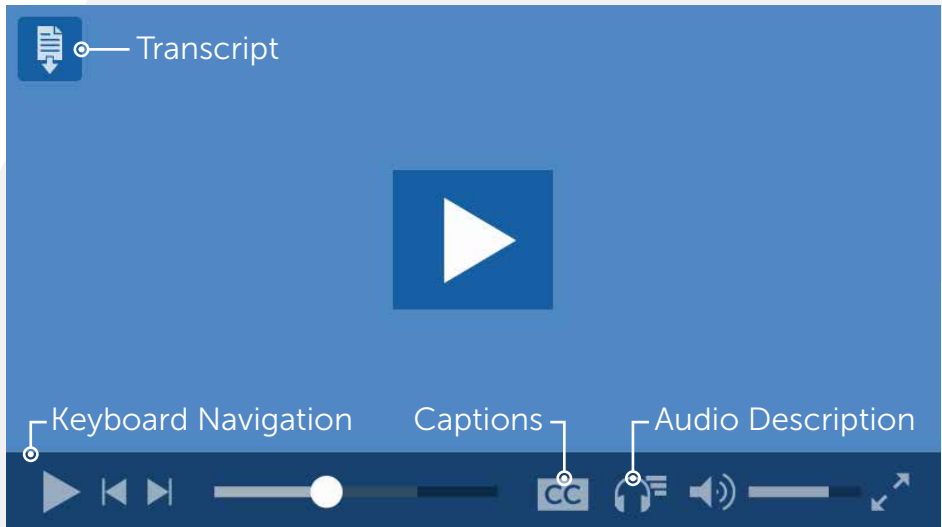

Multimedia Accessibility Requirements

Captions (CC) are a transcript of all audio elements of a video that are synchronised with the video. Captions cover all audio elements including dialogue, sound effects, and descriptions of music if they are important in the context of the video.

Transcript is a downloadable, written version of the material presented in the video. For vision impaired users, these can be read out by a screen reader at the user's preferred speed.

Keyboard Navigation supports keyboard control of the video player and allows your viewers to tab into the player, begin playback, adjust volume or seek through the video without needing to use a mouse.

Audio Description (AD) is a verbal commentary of key visual elements in the video, to make what is happening on screen clear through sound. Audio Description is an alternate audio track to the video that can be turned on or off in the player.
